## Who

Alum Rock, East Side Union High, Franklin-McKinley, Oakland, and Redwood City district public school teachers grades 6 – 12th are eligible to apply. A maximum of 2 grants available per school, and 1 grant per teacher each year.

## What

Teachers are encouraged to come up with new ideas for after school programs. Grants up to \$2,500 are available to cover costs of equipment, teacher time, and/or refreshments.

Examples: Running club, Dance club, Ecology club, Yearbook club, School choir, Skateboarding club, Drama club, Chess club, School newspaper team, Yoga club, Guitar club (school sports teams are not included).

## How

- Date and notation on top that request is for an After School Resource Grant

- Your name, grade level, email address
- Description of your after school program idea and how it will be implemented, duration of project, and number of students and grade level(s) served
- Total amount requested
- Item by Item listing of how the money will be spent
- Applications must be signed by both the submitting teacher and principal
