What

Grants of up to \$7,500 are available for non-profit programs serving Belle Haven and East Palo Alto.

Who

All organizations that meet the following criteria are welcome to apply:

- 501(c)(3) non-profits with a history of success in providing services to the Belle Haven community.
- 501(c)(3) non-profits with a history of success in providing services to the East Palo Alto community.

Please note:

- This year we are looking to support small, grassroots programs that have a big impact, and preference will be given to agencies with an annual budget of \$1 million or less. No grants will be given to agencies with budgets over \$1.5 million.
- An organization may apply for one grant each cycle. For example, please do not apply for a grant in Belle Haven and another one in East Palo Alto.
- If the Facebook Local Community Fund has funded your organization in the past and you would like to apply again, please provide an overview of the results of the most recent grant in 500 words or less.
- Public agencies, schools, and school foundations are not eligible.
- Nonprofits providing programming on a school campus are eligible. Please provide a letter of support about your work from the school principal/director.
