

Who

Any Children & Family Services Social Worker or Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) working with 6th-12th grade youth in Alameda, Contra Costa, San Francisco, San Mateo, and Santa Clara Counties.

What

Grants of up to \$250 will be awarded to fund extracurricular activities for youth. The grant can be renewed once.

Examples: piano lessons, cooking classes, summer camp.

How

Simply submit the following:

- 1) A one-page request on agency letterhead that includes:
- Notation that the request is for a Youth Opportunity Social Worker Grant
- Your name, title, address, email address, telephone and fax numbers
- Description of the youth, which activity they would like to do, and the reason needed (impact the grant will have on the youth)
- Total amount requested and item by item cost; checks can be made payable to the social worker, CASA or a vendor (you must include the address for any payee); check will be mailed to the social worker/CASA
- Application must have signature approval of your supervisor
 A one-page (maximum) essay from the youth that answer
 - 2) A one-page (maximum) essay from the youth that answers the following questions:
- What activity do you want to explore?
- What makes you passionate or excited about it?
