

MATHEMATICS RESOURCE GRANTS

Who Infant, toddler, and preschool teachers in programs serving low-income families and public school teachers of grades TK – 3 in San Mateo and Santa Clara Counties. Limit of 3 grants per site for TK-3 schools, and all other sites will depend on classroom size; one grant per teacher each year.

What

Grants up to \$500 are available to fund books, materials, software, manipulatives and professional development related to mathematics. We encourage requests which show curriculum resources are articulated between grade levels (ex. Pre-school with Kindergarten, 1st with 2nd grade, etc.).

How

Simply submit a description of your idea on school letterhead, including the following information:

- Date and notation on top that request is for a Mathematics Grant
- School and district name, address, telephone and fax numbers
- Your name, grade level and email address
- Description of your project
- Total amount requested
- Item by Item listing of how the money will be spent (we encourage same grade level teachers to apply together to maximize this resource grant)
- For TK-3rd grade teachers: Applications must be signed by both the submitting teacher and the school principal. For infant, toddler, and preschool teachers: applications must be signed by both the submitting teacher and the executive director of the program. ***(If you cannot get your application physically signed, please cc your principal/director when submitting your request by email and let them know to respond by confirming that they approve your application for review. This email will serve as their "signature")***
