



SCIENCE RESOURCE GRANTS

\$500 Grants for Science Instruction in TK-12th Grade Bay Area Classrooms

WHAT IS IT?

Grants of up to \$500 will be awarded to teachers for hands-on materials to enhance their classroom science instruction, with a focus on **life sciences and chemistry**.

Examples include:

- Safety goggles and lab coats
- Water testing materials
- Chemistry lab sets
- Kits (bird feeder kit, DNA kit, soil kit)
- Microscopes and slides

WHO CAN APPLY?

Any TK-12 teacher working at a low-income public school in Alameda, San Francisco, San Mateo, or Santa Clara County is eligible to apply.

A maximum of two grants will be awarded to a school, and one grant per teacher per school year.

HOW TO APPLY?

It's easy! Submit a request on school letterhead with the following information:

- Date and notation on top that request is for a Science Resource Grant
- School and district name, address, and telephone number
- Your name, grade level, email address
- Title 1 status and/or percentage of students eligible for Free and Reduced- Price Lunch
- Description of your classroom
- Total amount requested
- Item by Item listing of how the money will be spent
- Applications must be signed by both the submitting teacher and principal
- Who the check should be made payable to (school, district or PTA only) and the address the check should be mailed to.
